Arrival the Day of the Celebration

Students will arrive to the Church at least 15 minutes before Mass begins (at 9:45am).

***Dress Code**

Females

- Dress: Clean, modest and fit for the occasion. Pastel colors are preferable, but not required. No strapless, backless, thin straps or low cleavage dresses. Dress must be at least knee length or longer.
- Shoes: Clean, modest and fit for the occasion. No flip-flops, backless shoes, high hills, tennis shoes.

Males

- Clothes: Clean, modest and fit for the occasion. White shirt, dark tie and dark pants, preferable. (No jeans) Suits fit the occasion.
- Shoes: Clean, modest and fit for the occasion. No tennis shoes, sandals or flip-flops.
