Learning Targets

On August 6, 2013, Daniel Cardinal DiNardo, our bishop, promulgated the Catechetical Framework for Lifelong Faith Formation. This is the definitive framework by which catechesis is to be carried out in the Archdiocese of Galveston-Houston in all contexts.

This curriculum is designed in a way that the learning information follows a spiral pattern in that similar topics are discussed at a progressively deeper cognitive level each year and throughout the appropriate age of the learner (your child), beginning with early childhood and concluding with adulthood.

*Every week, you'll be provided with the the Learning Targets for different grade levels. All of them will help answer the EQ of the week. This week it is "What do you know about the life of Jesus Christ?"
Review with your child/ren on the days of the week where it has been indicated.*

EARLY CHILDHOOD [PREK AND KINDER]

- God is good.
- God loves all people.
- God teaches people how to love

ELEMENTARY [1-3RD GRADE]

- Jesus shows a brotherly love to all people.
- Jesus taught people how to love God by expressing gratitude to his Father and by being kind to others.
- Jesus is the model of love and goodness.
- Jesus is God and man. (*God is Jesus's divine Father and Mary His human mother*)
- Jesus, in faithfully following his Father's will, is the perfect example of God's love.

ELEMENTARY [4TH-6TH GRADE]

- Jesus is the perfect image of God, sent to show divine love and good-ness and to affirm the human potential for good.
- Jesus, by his life and teaching, taught people how to love God and others
- Jesus teaches that service and love to oth-ers is service and love to him.
- Jesus is one person with two natures: the eternal Word of God who becomes incar-nate in the person of Jesus.
- When one lives and serves others as Jesus did, one acknowledges that every person is created and loved by God.
- Love is the guiding principle of the gospel message

MATURE ADULTS [FOR ANY ADULT WHO WANTS TO GROW IN THEIR FAITH ALONG WITH OUR FF CHILDREN]

- Jesus models, commands, and empowers his disciples to follow his Way of Love.
- The mystery of the Most Holy Trinity: one God exists as a Trinity of persons existing in perfect and eternal communion with one another. This is the central mystery of the Christian faith and is known only because of God's self-revelation as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

- Jesus Christ, one person in two natures, is the center of all life and faith.
